Jointly hosted by the UNCITRAL Regional Centre for Asia and the Pacific (UNCITRAL-RCAP), the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Korea (MOJ), The Korean Commercial Arbitration Board (KCAB), the International Chambers of Commerce (ICC) and the Seoul International Dispute Resolution Centre (Seoul IDRC), the Conference this year will highlight various important aspects of international arbitration.

With an overview of the innovations made by International Arbitral Institutions, the Conference will deal with the topic on how to prevent abusive practice in arbitral proceedings. It will also feature outlook into new areas of international arbitration such as international factoring, tax, banking, finance and insolvency. Interestingly, the impact of Artificial Intelligence (AI) on international arbitration will be specially addressed. In addition, Investor-State Dispute Settlement (ISDS) reform will be discussed from both state and investor perspectives. Furthermore, sports arbitration as new frontier will be touched in celebration of the upcoming PyeongChang 2018 Winter Olympics.

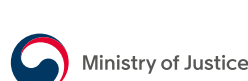
