Claimant's Recovery


24% of Claimants recovered 0 damages

Standards for Document Production




Standards for Document Production

- When granted, 44% of document production ordered was narrow categories
- All document requests were granted, either partially (50%) or in full (50%)

Assessments of Outcomes

- 83% of Respondent-affiliated AIQ Responders found the award "more favorable than expected"
- 53% of Claimant-affiliated responders found the award "as expected"




- Armesto is most often appointed as a Chairperson (83% of cases)
- As co-arbitrator, Armesto mostly appointed by Respondents in investment arbitrations and by Claimants in commercial arbitrations

Armesto's Roles on Tribunals



Timing

Duration of deliberations in investment arbitral proceedings is 421 days, which is shorter than the global average.




Recovery on Investment Claims

- 50% of direct expropriation and
 76% of indirect expropriation claims
 granted in full
- Average rates of recovery higher than global averages
- Costs and fees most frequently awarded to prevailing party or based on relative merits

Sources of Authority & Methodologies

- Other international treaties or instruments and scholarly treatises are primary source relied on in investment awards, on jurisdiction and merits
- Ordinary meaning and precedent analysis are primary interpretive methodologies
- Schreuer is most frequently cited scholar


