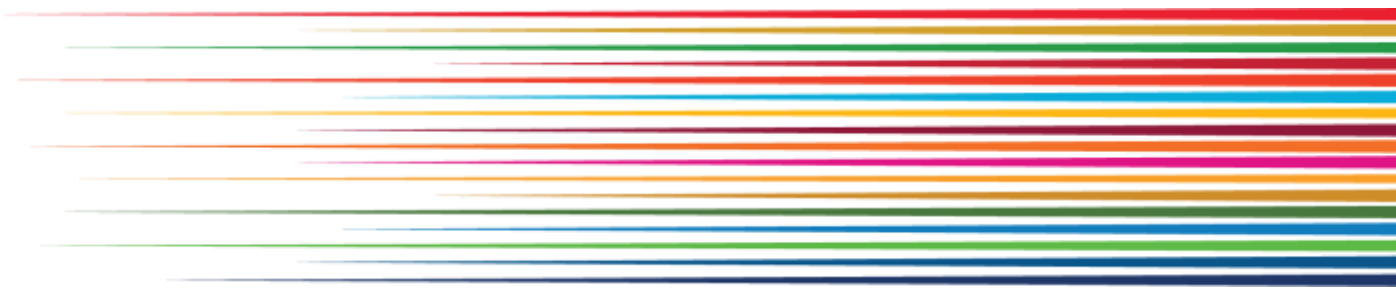

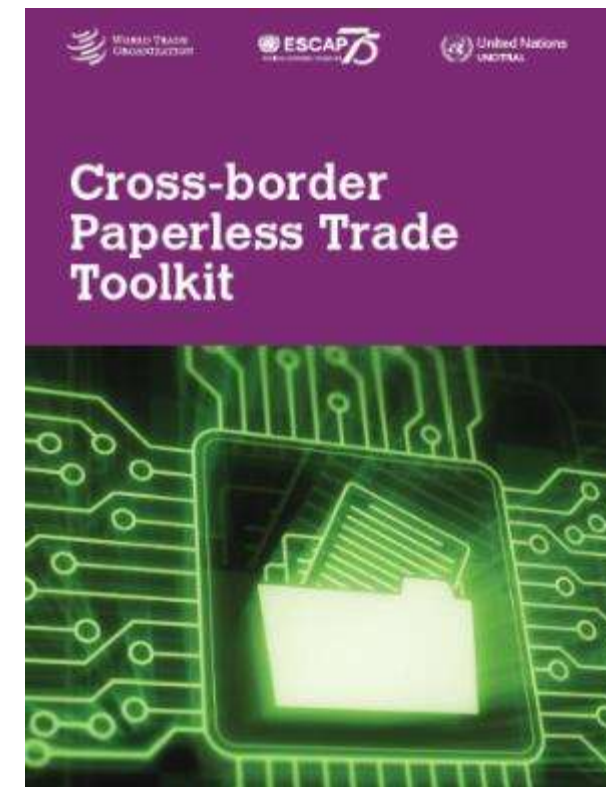

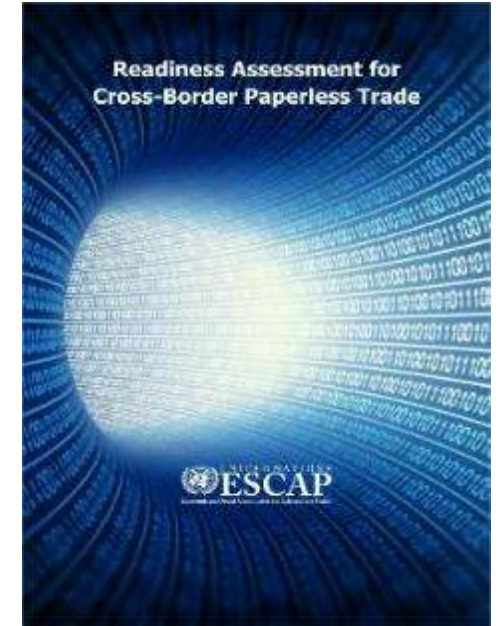

Good Practices

- ✓ BGD: update of assessment – ADB SASEC Integrated TF SDP
- ✓ PHL: streamlining via NSW-TWG
- ✓ TLS: e-commerce law (draft)
- ✓ TUV: Acceded to ECC & CPTA



Challenges & Lessons learned

- Obsolete, outdated laws – drafting based on general principles
- Lack of coordination – Champion/leading agency
- Partnership, partnership!

Framework Agreement on the Facilitation of Cross-Border Paperless Trade in Asia and the Pacific (CPTA) <https://www.unescap.org/projects/cpta>

- ❑ Adopted by the Commission as a UN treaty (resolution 72/4) in May 2016
- ❑ The Framework Agreement entered into force on **20 February 2021**.
- ❑ Open to interested (53) ESCAP member states (voluntary) to become parties
- ❑ To facilitate cross-border paperless trade (data exchange) among willing ESCAP member states by providing a dedicated intergovernmental framework to develop legal and technical solutions
