## Mission of the Korea Legislation Research Institute (KLRI)

In July 1990, the KLRI was established to support national legislation and to serve domestic and comparative legal research networks.

The KLRI is the only government-funded research institute specializing in legislation in the Republic of Korea.

#### **Purpose of Establishment**

The Korea Legislation Research Institute was founded on the basis of the Act on the Establishment, Operation and Fostering of Government-Funding Research Institutes, etc.

The KLRI provides assistance in the formation of national(governmental) legislative policies, promotes dissemination of timely and accurate legislative information, and supports general legislative activities by systematically collecting and managing legislative information, and by investigating and researching on the legislative system with extensive expertise.

#### **Primary Functions**

- Investigation and research on foreign and domestic laws and legislative policies
- > Systematic integration, management, dissemination and computer networking of foreign and domestic legislative information
- > Publication and supply of the Code of Laws of Korea, and if needed, explanatory materials concerning the purpose and background of individual laws
- Survey and research on legislation skills, legal terminology, Korea's old legal codes before the introduction of the current legal system, and the history of the Korean legal system
- > Joint-research with overseas or domestic institutions on legal systems and legislative policies, and invitation of legal experts for research
- Entrustment of research projects to domestic research institutes or individuals as well as performance of research projects entrusted by the Government or private organizations
