KMOJ and RCAP: Celebrating 10 years of Partnership

Good morning, excellencies and distinguished participants on and offline.

Let me start with my personal relationship with RCAP. On 10th January 2012, I attended the opening ceremony of RCAP. 10 years have passed, and I once again attended this event, RCAP@10 today. When RCAP first opened, I remember that Songdo, Incheon, where RCAP is located, was very bleak as it had just been newly developed. Over the past decade, the city has grown, and Central Park, which is next to RCAP, has become a popular tourist destination.

Meanwhile, our RCAP has also developed. RCAP, which started as a project office, has now become an integral part of UNCITRAL and is actively carrying out activities for the harmonization and modernization of international trade law while disseminating UNCITRAL rules in the Asia-Pacific region.

As you know, the Korean Ministry of Justice (KMOJ) has been working closely with RCAP for the past 10 years.

In addition, KMOJ has co-hosted many events with RCAP, including the UNCITRAL ADR Special Session, RCAP's annual flagship event, which was also held yesterday this year, and the biennial Incheon Law & Business Forum, together with Incheon Metropolitan City.

The relationship between KMOJ and RCAP has also developed over the past decade. In the early days of RCAP, our ministry acted as a guardian of RCAP, but as RCAP has much grown since then, we now think of RCAP as a partner with us.

As the Vice-Minister said before, KMOJ hopes RCAP will become a focal point for the development of international trade law in the Asia-Pacific region. As RCAP's home country and ten-year partner of the RCAP, we are committed to supporting RCAP in a full manner.

Again, I'm very delighted to celebrate RCAP's 10th anniversary with you all.
